The above named licensee is licensed to export the prescribed product referred to above under the provisions of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987. This licence is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The licensee will carry out exporting operations under the authority of this licence in such a way as to not to prejudice the Export Marketing Strategy current from time to time for the prescribed product to which this licence relates (as outlined in Section 37 of the Act).
- 2. The licensee shall keep such records and supply such information to the Authority, in the manner and at the time required by the Authority, as is notified in writing by the Authority to the licensee from time to time, to enable the Authority to carry out its functions under the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987.
- 3. Where the licensee is a company it shall immediately advise the Authority of any changes to its share structure or ownership which result in any person or entity having effective control of the licensee where that effective control was not held at the date on which the licensee made its application. For the purposes of this paragraph "effective control" shall mean the right to control more than 50% of the shares or voting power of the licensee. If the Authority deems that "effective control" has changed, then the licence expires.
- 4. Under section 34(1) no person shall export any prescribed product unless that person holds an export licence in respect of that product. A licence holder cannot lawfully lend or otherwise allow another company or agent to use their export licence.
- 5. The Authority has the power under section 38 to impose additional conditions on a licence where it is satisfied that prejudice to the export marketing strategy has occurred, and that it is appropriate to impose conditions on the exporter's licence to prevent any repetition or continuance of that prejudice.

Under section 39 of the Act the Authority may revoke or suspend a licence if the licensed exporter has failed to comply with any condition attached to the licence; or since the licence was granted, the exporter has been convicted of an offence relating to the export of the product for which the licence was granted or

to exporting generally, and in the opinion of the Authority the offence is of such a nature as to cast doubt on the ability of the applicant to carry out exporting operations properly.

THIS LICENCE is dated the 22nd day of April 2020 and is valid for five years from this date.
